2. Amber Ales – BJCP Categories 9D & 10B
3. Brown Ales – BJCP Categories 10C & 11A, 11B, 11C
4. Porter – BJCP Categories 12A & 12B
5. Stout – BJCP Categories 13A, 13B, 13C, & 13E

Bottles must be free of all paper labels, and any lettering or numbering must be blacked out from caps. Swing-top bottles are accepted. Please rubber band bottle tags to bottles.
